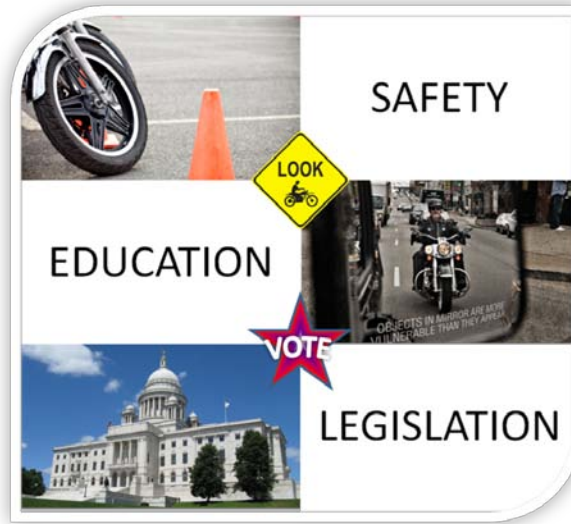


OUR MISSION
